**AVONDALE SCOUT RESERVATION
SHOOTING SPORTS PERMIT FORM
Instruction Sheet**

Groups:

Print the district name and unit in which your group is registered.

Check whether your Scout Group (Troop or Crew) is registered in the Istroma Area Council (IAC) or another Scout Council (OC) and print the name of the other council. A Non-Scout Group is one that is composed of adult and youth participants that are not registered with an official Scout Group. This may include church groups, YMCA, Boys and Girls Clubs, and other youth serving organizations. Non-Scout Groups must complete a hold-harmless agreement and provide evidence of a \$1 million liability insurance policy.

Number of Participants:

Indicate the number of participants that compose your group. A registered Scout Youth or Adult is one whose name appears on the official roster for the Troop or Crew. All other participants are non-registered youth or adults.

Dates Requested:

Indicate the dates and expected time of arrival and departure.

Activity and Range Requested:

Check the activity and lake you want to use. You must communicate with the personnel at the council office 926-2697, to determine which range is available for shooting sports activities on the desired dates. An entire camping area including the range could be reserved for large district camporees and would be off-limits to other participants. Once a specific range is determined to be available, a group may apply to use it on a first come-first served basis.

Rifle Rental:

Groups may only rent rifles for use on the Avondale Scout Reservation. The Avondale rifles meet the requirement BSA national criteria for single shot, .22 caliber rifles. This separate form must be completed in addition to the Avondale Camp Use Form. The use of the Shooting Ranges must be under the direct supervision of a current NRA Certified Rifle and Shotgun Instructor (Range Officer). The Range Officer must be physically present on the range at all times when rifles and ammunition are present. Calculate fee.

Equipment Needed:

Indicate the number of each item you will need for your shooting activity. Rifles, ear protection, and eye protection, rifle-cleaning items are available for rent. The Scout group must provide shotguns, skeet, rifle targets and ammunition.

Signatures:

Complete the required information. The NRA Instructor should submit a copy of his/her NRA Certification Card showing the ID Number, Expiration Date and Ratings held (i.e. IRA, ISA) to the Council Office personnel to be placed on file and entered into the BSA database. The Committee Chairperson's signature confirms that the unit is aware of the activity and attests to the training of the adults involved on this Shooting Sports activity.

Fees Due:

Transfer the fees circled in each block to the summary block and total the total fees due. The fees will be paid on the Avondale Camp Use Permit Form, which has to be submitted with this form.
