



## Council Refund Policy

The following policy statement is applicable to all Council and District events where a fee is collected. This includes such events as Day Camps, Cub Resident Camp, Summer Camp, Winter Camp, training courses, camporees, district events, etc.

1. **Written refund requests** will be considered only if received in the Pennington Scout Center **ten (10) days prior to the start of the activity.**
2. **Written refund requests** submitted after the event will be **considered only for personal illness or family emergencies.** No refund requests will be accepted **after ten (10) days following the close of the activity.**
3. A service charge of **twenty-five percent (25%) of the full activity fee will be assessed on all refunds.**
4. Refund **checks will be issued within 30 days** following the close of the event.
5. **Fees are only transferable** within the same unit to a Scout not currently registered for the activity.

# **PREREQUISITES**

**FOR ALL MERIT BADGES—PLEASE OBTAIN THE MERIT BADGE PAMPHLET AND READ IT BEFORE COMING TO THE CLASS(ES). Prerequisites should be completed and brought to class with you.**

## **ARCHAEOLOGY**

#8-10 must be done outside of class.

## **AVIATION**

Prerequisite: #5

Parents are needed to help transport scouts to airport terminal.

## **BIRD STUDY**

Prerequisite: #8 (bring a picture of your project to class)

## **COIN COLLECTING**

Scout must bring 5 different state quarters.

Scout must bring 1 coin, from current circulation, of each denomination (penny, nickel, dime, quarter, half dollar, and dollar [Eisenhower, Anthony, or Sacagawea]).

If Scout has a collection to satisfy requirement #9, he can also bring it.

## **COLLECTIONS**

If Scout has a collection to satisfy requirement #5b, they need to bring it or a photo of the collection to class.

## **FAMILY LIFE**

Requirements #3-5 must be done at home.

## **CITIZENSHIP IN THE COMMUNITY**

Prerequisite: #3a, 3b 4b, and 4c

## **CITIZENSHIP IN THE WORLD**

Prerequisite: #4b, 7a, and 7b

## **COMMUNICATIONS**

Prerequisite: 1a or b

## **DISABILITIES AWARENESS**

You may complete requirements 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 prior to class and bring with you to class.

## **FIRE SAFETY**

Prerequisite: #6a

## **JOURNALISM**

#2 must be done outside of class.

## **LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE**

Prerequisite: 2a or b

## **LAW**

- A) Read the merit badge pamphlet before meeting and be ready to discuss.
- B) Do Requirement #4 (interviewing five people regarding the role of law enforcement officers in our society).

## **OCEANOGRAPHY**

#7 and 8 cannot be completed in class.

## **PUBLIC HEALTH**

#7 cannot be completed here. Prerequisite: #8

## **SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION**

Prerequisite: 2d, 3c, 5a, 6d, 7e
