21st Century Wood Badge 2012

The Istrouma Area Council will once again offer a Wood Badge course in the Spring of 2012. This training is a participant-friendly course for Scout Leaders of all programs –Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Venturing - and will provide the skills that will help you become a more effective leader and to put together high-performance teams to make your Den and Pack grow, make your Boy Scout Troop go, and take your Venturing Crew to the next peak.

Wood Badge has two parts. The first is the two 3-day weekends of practical experience where you learn skills and concepts that underscore the five Themes of the 21st Century Wood Badge: Bringing the Vision to Life, Models for Success, Tools of the Trade, Leading to Make a Difference, and Living the Values.

In the second part of the course, you create a “ticket” to put those skills into action. You will be awarded Wood Badge Beads and a Woggle and Neckerchief upon successful completion of your ticket.

Cost of the course is \$235.00. This fee includes meals, one activity t-shirt and program materials. A deposit of \$50.00 along with this application will insure your place in our Spring 2012 course. All fees due by February 29, 2012.

21st Century Wood Badge Training requires two 3-day Weekends:

1st Course Weekend – April 13-15, 2012

Friday, 7:30 a.m. – Sunday late afternoon Avondale Scout Reservation

2nd Course Weekend – May 4-6, 2012

Friday, 7:00 a.m. – Sunday late afternoon Avondale Scout Reservation

Attendance at all sessions on both weekends is required. Your patrol will also set two patrol meetings at the group’s convenience between the first and second weekends. Attendance at these patrol meetings is also required. An Annual Health and Medical Record Form is required for the course.
